## **ABOUT NYEF:**

National Youth Equity Forum (NYEF) is a membership based collective of/for socially excluded young people striving to promote leadership and equal opportunity for youth towards achieving their social, education, economic and cultural rights with a vision to build a just and socially inclusive society for all.

Currently, NYEF evolving as a membership based youth led movement consisting over 5000 members across structured and organised youth led collectives as Bihar Ambedkar Students' Forum (BASF), Uttar Pradesh Youth Equity Forum (UPYEF) and Delhi Youth Equity Forum (DYEF). NYEF vision is to nurture young leadership among socially excluded communities i.e. Dalit, Adivasi, Muslim, Nomadic Tribes & De-Notified Tribes, voice out their concerns of growing inequalities and aligned together for community based actions to transform and influence their self, society and governance!

On the principle of educate, agitate and organize, around 140 fellows and thousands of motivated cadres across states is able to push the agenda of social equity & inclusion in the area of education, health (SRHR), employability and entrepreneurial education by keeping the national and global goals of "leave no one behind" in the frame of SDGs and Constitutional mandate of promoting equality, liberty, fraternity and justice for all!

# **Highlights of Jan-Feb 2022**

- Over 2000 girls from 4 districts of Bihar sent written post cards to the Prime Minister Office asking and advocating for equitable and inclusive education for all girls!
- 18 Young fellows completed "Jagriti Yatra (Digital version)" to walk on the path of discovery and transformation
- Fight Against Inequality Campaign reached out to hundreds of community members in different parts of Delhi led by DYEF Street theatre group
- 30 youths from 12 districts of Bihar onboarded as "Dr. Ambedkar Fellowship" journey for 18 months, through on ground biennial election of BASF
- 24 adolescents from "Musahar Community" onboarded as "CLAY fellows" on a journey of self to society for 27 months.
- 15 Women were supported to start their own "Start Up Business" who had lost earning member in family due to Covid-19
